challenges of her disability to become an **international para-athlete** (disability sports) with 8 national & 3 international medals at **World Para Athletics Grand Prix** competitions; a psychological **counsellor**; **International Disability Inclusion Advocate** & TEDx Speaker and social entrepreneur - co-founder of the **Wheeling Happiness Foundation**. The foundation promotes inclusion, disability sports, raises funds for people with disabilities and promotes better access and equality for those facing physical, emotional and social challenges. The foundation believes in the transformative power of sport and has helped over 50 persons with disabilities to become sportspersons, and provided artificial limbs & assistive devices to 500+ beneficiaries thereby focusing on **abilities beyond disability** and enabling self-reliance & emotional well-being. More than 10,000 people have been impacted by the co-founders' workshops, awareness & outreach efforts. ACCESSIBILITY AND INCLUSION FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES:

- We conduct Disability Awareness Initiative Workshops in Rural Haryana, impacting approximately 300 people per workshop.

 mother to two sons, who we have helped to become a para-athlete starting in 2015, has
 won many national & international medals in wheelchair shotput & javelin including Bronze
 medal in Beijing 2017 World Para Athletics Grand Prix, and represented India at Asian Para
 Games 2018.
- We currently have an ongoing collaboration with Meer Foundation whereby we are identifying budding para-athletes and providing them good quality active wheelchairs, to enhance their mobility & improve sport performance.
